REPORTING SAFETY CONCERNS

Do you have valid concerns about workplace safety? Report them to OSHA, GTFF, and/or UO to help ensure safer policies are put in place

For additional information on OSHA: You are free to file safety complaints; it is your right. OSHA only investigates and punishes employers, not workers.

Not all concerns are necessarily OSHA complaints but still might be worth raising to GTFF or UO!



What might be an OSHA violation?

- 1** If **any** individual with confirmed COVID-19 had been present in your building, but UO did not notify all workers in the building when they learned the individual was diagnosed with COVID-19
- 2** If an instructor in your workspace (e.g., in a class you are assigned to) **does not wear a mask indoors**
- 3** If you have reason to believe UO's notification to you of COVID exposure **took them more than 24 hours** since they became aware of the exposure
- 4** If a student or employee who tested positive for COVID was near you in class for more than 15 minutes, but you were not notified of the exposure by UO (i.e., if you only heard of exposure through word-of-mouth).
